She lives her life on camera, so it's no surprise Kris Jenner is trying to stop the clock! The 61-year-old juggles the Kardashians empire, six kids, family drama ... and what appear to be regular appointments with the plastic surgeon. "Her Botox is not overdone," observes Dr. Lyle Back, who doesn't treat the momager, "but overfilling is making her cheeks look 'chipmunky.'" He cites the "parentheses" around Kris' mouth as a sign of too much filler. But he praises the injectables around her eyes,

saying the reality star looks "younger and fresher." Kris' lips are puffier, too, likely due to filler, says Dr. Steve Fallek, also not her doc. Kris' 2011 face-lift — which she shared with viewers on *Keeping Up With the Kardashians* — is holding up, probably augmented by Botox and laser treatments, adds Dr. Fallek. Whatever she's doing to "keep up" with her famous daughters, the glamorous grandma clearly remains a fan of what she calls "freshening up!" **LS**

FOREHEAD

Dr. Kally Papantoniou, who does not treat Kris, says Botox is keeping her forehead smooth and her brows elevated. Injections are \$500 to \$2K every three months.

NOSE

"She's had at least one or two revision nose surgeries," Dr. Lyle Back says of Kris' honker. Cost of rhinoplasty: \$7.5K.

CHEEKS

Dermal fillers are plumping the momager's cheeks, speculates Dr. Papantoniou. Price starts at \$1K, depending on the number of syringes.

LIPS

To achieve a fuller, rounder mouth like Kris', expect to spend around \$1,000 per visit, says Dr. Steve Fallek. Results can last up to a year.
